Brimonidine works by reducing blood vessels. Topical Brimonidine (for the skin) is used to treat facial rosaza (enlarged blood vessels in the face) in adults. Topical Brimonidine may also be used for purposes not listed in this medication manual. Follow all directions on your drug label and package. Tell each of your healthcare providers about all your medical conditions, allergies, and all the medications you use. You shouldn't use topical rimonidine if you're allergic to rimonyndine. To make sure topical brimonidine is safe for you, tell your doctor if you have: It is not known if this drug will harm an unborn baby. Tell your doctor if you're pregnant or planning to get pregnant. It is not known if topical brimonidine passes to breast milk or if it can harm a breastfeeding baby. You should not breastfeed while using this drug. Follow all directions on your prescription label. I do not have to humidize this drug in larger or smaller quantities or for longer than recommended. Use topical brimonidine once a day unless your doctor tells you otherwise. Apply a pea-sized amount of this drug to any affected area of the face (forehead, nose, chin, and any cheek). Try not to get any medicine near your eyes or on your lips. Don't use this medicine on open wounds or sunburn. Dry, cracked or irritated skin. Wash your hands after applying this medication. Store at room temperature away from salt and heat. Keep this drug out of reach of children. Topical Brimonidine can cause serious medical problems in a child who accidentally swallows the drug. Seek urgent medical attention if that happens. Apply the missed dosage as soon as you remember. Skip the missed dosage if it's almost time for your next dose. Do not use additional drug to compensate for missed dosage. Topical brimonidine overdose is unlikely to be dangerous. Seek urgent medical attention or call the helpline at Poison 1-800-222-1222 if someone accidentally ingested the drug. Don't take it through your mouth. Topical brimonidine is for use only on the skin of your face. Avoid getting topical brimonidine in your eyes or mouth. Get urgent medical help if you have signs of an allergic reaction: hives; Hard breathing; Swelling of your face, lips, tongue or throat. Stop using topical brimonidine and call your doctor at once if you have: dizzy or feeling dizzy; Slow heartbeat; Or severe skin redness, burning or other irritation. It's not great for the treatment of Lesions (papules and pus) of rosacea. Although a number of drugs are approved to treat inflammatory rosacea, there are currently no approved drugs directly targeting rosacea's erythema, making it a key missed medical need. Brimonidine is the first and only FDA-approved topical treatment specially developed and indicated for facial erythema in rosacea. Applied once a day, brimonidine works quickly to reduce the redness of rosacea and the beneficial effects last up to 12 hours. Brimonidine is also available as eye drops to treat ocular hypertension or glaucoma. How does brimonidine work? While the exact cause of rosacea erythema is unknown, it is hypothesized that erythema stems from estistoration in dermatous vasomotor reactions, which leads to abnormal prosthesis of facial blood vessels on various stimuli. Studies show the involvement of adrenaline receptors in neurosocular throttling trajectory. Brimonidine is a relatively selective Alpha-2 agonist. Topical application of brimonidine may reduce erythema by contracting dilated facial blood vessels to reduce the redness of rosacea.
